If in your studies you have focussed on for example: development or environmental economics, environmental and social sustainability, climate change or natural resource management, and you have experience working with SDGs, theories of change, setting KPIs researching on impact, keep reading.

**All our investments**, whether they are in energy projects, the agricultural value chain, funds or financial institutions, must follow international ESG best practice as well as deliver impact in support of the green transition and building a just and inclusive economy. We think innovatively about ways to deploy our capital, attract, and mobilise other investors to drive transformational change and create sustainable impact in the poorest countries of the world.

**The Sustainability and Impact team** consists of 4 professionals and 1 student, all reporting to the VP Sustainability and Impact.

#### **Key tasks of the role:**

- Assists with sustainability analysis in and country risk assessments to be used as part of the due diligence on potential investments
- Collect sustainability and impact reporting and information on project companies and investments partners
- Log key data into IFU IT systems
- Contribute to the development and update of tools on sustainability and impact to be used by the organisation
- Conduct research/ analysis on sustainability/impact areas

**The key qualifications** include that you are about to complete a relevant BA from CBS, KU, RUC, AAU or other relevant institution and you want to continue your MSc in that direction as well. We expect you have high grades and can demonstrate your knowledge and interest in the Sustainability/Impact area.

You should have strong competencies and skills within data analysis and documentation, demonstrating a clear sense for details. MS Office tools are all well-known to you, and especially Excel and PowerPoints are programmes you master.

Company language is English, and you must demonstrate a high proficiency.

**We expect you to work 15-20 hours a week. It varies according to workload.**
