

LEGAL COUNSEL FINANCE FOR IMPACT INVESTMENTS AT IFU, PLACED IN COPENHAGEN

IFU is looking for a Legal Counsel Finance for Impact investments. Do you want to work in an international investment fund, creating economic and social progress in developing countries through impact investments? IFU makes direct equity and debt investments using IFU's own funds and as a fund manager for a number of investment funds. There is no managerial responsibility in the role. You will report to the Vice President, Legal.

IFU is an active partner in the investments we make during project development, due diligence, deal structuring and project signing, as well as through the subsequent establishment and operation or further development of the company

You must be motivated by contributing to investments in the most challenging markets in Africa, Asia, Latin America and Europe with the aim of supporting economic development.

THE JOB

You will support the investment organization in mainly debt transactions with due diligence and provide legal advice in relation to the financing of impact investments (such as corporate finance, project finance, guarantees as well as grant arrangements with or without repayment obligations). This includes the preparation, review and negotiation of legal documentation and assisting in structuring transactions. You will be involved in the entire process, and your advice plays a significant role. From time to time the transactions will require you to travel abroad to visit the project, and travel may occur at short notice. However, we try to be as flexible as possible in order to maintain a healthy work/life balance. In addition to providing legal advice, you may be involved in legal ad hoc tasks within compliance/legal risk management, e.g. regarding money laundering legislation, sanctions, GDPR, tax law, etc., and you will also handle contact to external lawyers.

The job is exciting and professionally challenging. It is important that you are able to manage your time effectively. We often work on several transactions at the same time. You must be able to look ahead, know our processes very well and know when to help, challenge and support.

WHAT WE OFFER

In the office in central Copenhagen, you will meet many different cultures and highly skilled colleagues, working across functions and not least making a difference according to IFU's investment strategy. You will be part of the Legal team of 9 people. We all work on transactions together with the project managers. We also share knowledge and prepare new contract formats, and as Legal Counsel you will be an integral part of that and of advising your colleagues. We constantly strive to be goal-oriented, efficient and keeping high standards.

QUALIFICATIONS

Lawyer with experience from banking or finance

- You have a master's degree in law or business law – preferably trained to be an attorney and with solid knowledge about Danish law
- 3-5 years of experience with high-level legal advice within banking and finance and experience with transactions. Good (contract) drafting skills. Experience with typical LMA standard loan agreements and project finance is a must, and experience with fund of funds investments is an advantage
- It is not a requirement that you have experience with the regions where IFU invests, however, an interest in developing countries, emerging markets and risk investments is an advantage
- You are fluent in Danish and English, and proficiency in Spanish or French is an advantage
