Job purpose:

The position is part of the finance team, reporting to the Senior Finance Manager. The main responsibility of this position is to conduct valuations of IFU’s portfolio of investments for IFU’s financial accounts and to prepare quarterly external investor reports. Furthermore, the team assists the investment professionals in making financial modelling and valuation in connection with due diligence of new investments and exits.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Prepare valuations of IFU’s portfolio of investments to be used as a basis for reporting.
- Prepare quarterly external investor reports, financial reporting to IFU’s board and reporting to other stakeholders.
- Validate and control financial input for the portfolio of investments.
- Perform treasury-related tasks regarding currency trading, entering into currency hedges and placement of excess liquidity.
- Support IFU’s investment professionals in financial analysis, financial modelling and valuation for potential new investments and exits.
